



Club Showcase Guidelines

Presentations and Showcases are the lifeblood of an organization like ours. We want to see your images and efforts and the Club Showcase is a simple and easy way for you to participate. Members will enjoy the presentations and possibly learn from the work of others.

Below are simple guidelines to help you prepare and present your Showcase. It's easy!

Time: Up to 10 minutes, including any commentary.

Photo Format: The preferred format is .jpg, but any type that will show on our laptop is acceptable.

Image Size: As large as possible and not less than 900 pixels on longest side the system will automatically fit it to the screen edit your images, right side up, and in order.

Software used: Powerpoint, Zoom Browser and Media Player.

Bring on: CD/DVD or USB memory stick.
(please avoid using your laptop as it takes time to set up)

When ready: Email Deborah Kellett (kldkellett@ns.sympatico.ca) to let her know you have one ready and she will put you on the list. We will show as many as possible each meeting.

Presentation: Advance slides as desired:

- Tell operator, or, do it yourself.
- Or, set specific time intervals.
- Self-running – with or without music.
- Use programs like Pro Show Gold (club owns).

Introduction: We would like to hear from you about your presentation. State your name and what your photos are about at the beginning of your presentation indicate, any special effects, techniques, unusual shots others can learn from your images, as well as enjoy.

Other:

- A laser pointer is available.
- Many members are available to assist you with any aspect, simply ask.
- One contributor will be chosen each year to receive a free membership.
