

# Team Theme Scavenger Hunt

**When:** November 15<sup>th</sup> - 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. (Rain Date is November 22<sup>nd</sup>)

**Where:** Meeting at Acadia Hall to Register and then moving throughout the HRM. Teams can be predetermined with 3 to 4 members or made up at the time of Registration for members who show up.

**What:** The “Team Theme Scavenger Hunt” will be a variation on the previous team scavenger hunts. This time teams will be able to pick from a list of pre-determined themes. Once they have chosen the theme they want to do they can go anywhere in the HRM Area to work on their choice. Teams will then return to the Start to have their pictures downloaded on to a laptop.

**Details:** At the Start point there will be a display board with a list of several “themes” that each Team can choose from. **Themes can only be used by one Team**, so that each Team will be doing a different subject. Teams will have their choice of selection in the order that the Team arrives at the Start point. The themes will be on general subjects that can be found in and around HRM. I.E., sidewalks (example only).

Each Team will be asked to submit a minimum of 75 pics and a maximum of 100 pics on their particular Theme. These pictures will be made in to a presentation and shown at the Club’s December 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting and voted on by the Club Members.

To make the presentation interesting Teams are encouraged to use any and all means of in-camera “tricks” such as B&W, colour variations, macro, blur, etc. The idea is to make their presentation as interesting as possible to the viewers. Darlene/Ken will put the presentation together from the pictures given, but will not do any editing other than some cropping if it seems to remove only excess that doesn’t effect the picture. Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> best presentation, as voted on by Club Members.

This is a good opportunity for those who want to try “daring” things with their camera. Use humour, use lighting, use props, whatever you want to try! As long as you stay with your *Theme*. Now is the time to forget the Rules and do something “different”. Be creative, be silly, do it your way!
