

Taking Photos over 4 Seasons

1. Mark your spot somehow and make sure you can find it in all seasons.
2. Take along previous images to help orient yourself for composition.
3. Take shots at various times even in each season to get the best ones (i.e. sky, flowers, fall leaves, snow etc.)
4. Take larger shots and then crop and resize to suite
5. Stitch together in a series to suite (by enlarging the canvas and copying and pasting).

Note: as with me, it may take you more than 1 year to get all the good shots you want.
