How to Submit Your Photos

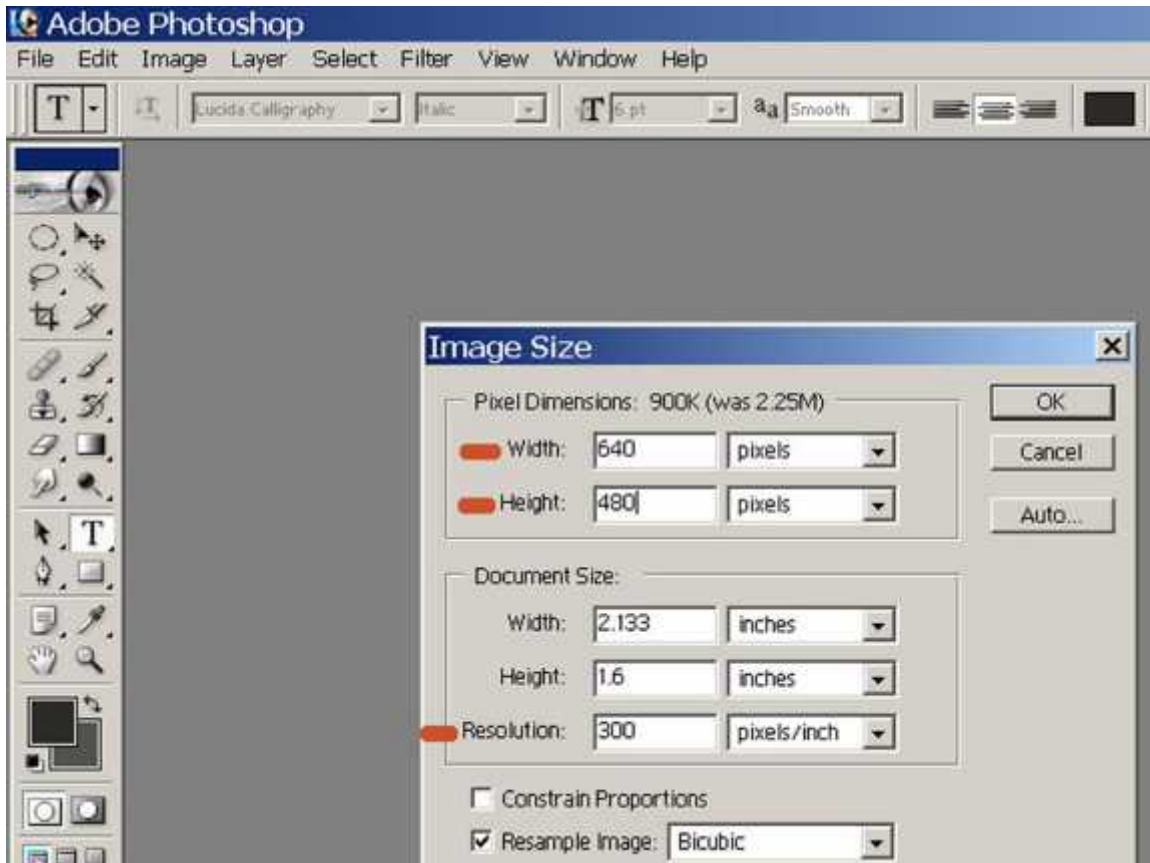
We are always looking to update and/or add new pictures to the Members' Photo Gallery. You may change your photos at any point, just let me know which ones to put on, and, take off. Pictures for the SPC Members' Gallery should be of your best work.

When preparing images for use in a website it is very important to optimize file sizes so images will display quickly and with good quality. When files are saved as JPEGs you can specify the amount of compression that is used. This will affect both the quality of the image and how fast it will display in a browser window. People with a high-speed internet connection may not notice much difference in the time to display an image but people with a dial up connection will notice a huge difference. There is always a trade-off between quality and length of time to display an image. Images must display quickly or people will leave your website.

Pictures should be a maximum of 640 pixels on one side. The maximum height or width can be 640 pixels, ie: 640w x 480h or 480w x 640h is okay. Files should be saved as a JPEG with medium-high quality (6-7). Pictures may be re-sized at the discretion of the web master to fit the available space. When saving and sending your photo's, if you could make sure that they approx. 100 kb in file size. (Resizing below in Photoshop).

Pictures for the Members' Gallery may also include a description about the creation of the image. A brief note about the location/subject, or any details telling how you achieved your results. Aperture, f-stop, film speed etc. (This is optional).

ie: Title: Bluer than Blue, Camera: Cannon Rebel Digital
AE; 1/250; 5.0; ISO 100; 100mm macro; window light; manual focus

Members may submit a maximum of ten images at one time for their gallery. You may update your gallery whenever you wish. A maximum of six images will be displayed at any one time. You should specify which pictures you want removed when submitting new pictures to update your gallery.

When sending pictures by email, please 'attach' them as opposed to inserting. (if you insert them I will not receive them properly and will need you to re-send them). You may email your photos to the following email address
